

# Short Game

Birdies by **Gator Todd** and **Matt Hughes** in a team playoff completed Alabama's come-from-behind victory at the Carpet Capital Collegiate Sunday. The defending tournament champs were seven strokes back of South Carolina entering the final day but shot a six-under 282—with Hughes posting a 67—to finish tied with the Gamecocks at five-over 869 at The Farm GC in Rocky Face, Ga. Hughes, playing in his hometown, birdied eight of his last 10 holes to finish T-10. Georgia Tech sophomore **Chesson Hadley** claimed the individual title with an eight-under 208. ... Despite losing three All-Americans from last year's team, the Lamar men opened the fall with a victory at the Gopher Invitational Sunday. The Cardinals shot a four-over 868 at Spring Hill GC in Wayzata, Minn., 22 strokes clear of Arkansas and Wisconsin. **Casey Clendenon** shared medalist honors with Wisconsin's **Danny Zimmerman**, shooting a one-under 215. ... **Michael McCoy** defeated **Eoghan O'Connell**, 4 and 3, to win the 83rd George A. Crump Memorial Tournament at Pine Valley (N.J.) CC Sunday. It was the third Crump title for McCoy in four years. **Vinny Giles** won the senior championship, beating **Allan Small**, 4 and 3.

### **Jesse Barnsley,** **Pepperdine**

The senior from Albuquerque played in front of a hometown crowd at the William H. Tucker Invitational and had fans cheering with a 12-under 204 to win medalist honors by eight strokes. His first college victory also helped the Waves claim the team title.



### **Lisa Maunu,** **Notre Dame**

While leading the Fighting Irish, which shot a school-best six-over 870, to the team title at the Cougar Classic in Hanahan, S.C., the junior also broke ND's 18- and 54-hole individual records with a first-round 66 and a six-under 210 to win her first college event.
