GOLF WORLD COLLEGE PLAYERS OF THE WEEK



George Bryan IV, South Carolina

The sophomore followed a second-round 66 at Forest Heights CC in Statesboro, Ga., and emerged from a six-way tie for the lead at the Schenkel E-Z-Go Invitational with a final-round 69 to shoot an eight-under 208 and earn his first college title. A birdie on the par-5 18th Sunday gave the Chapin, S.C., native a one-stroke victory over Alabama's Michael Thompson. The Gamecocks finished third behind No. 1 Alabama and Florida.



Alison Whitaker, Duke

A career-low opening-round 65 at RedTail GC in Sorrento, Fla., helped propel the sophomore from Australia to a wire-to-wire victory at the UCF Challenge with an eight-under 208. The win was the first of her college career and also earned her an exemption into the LPGA's Ginn Tribute, May 29-June 1. Meanwhile, the Blue Devils cruised to an 11-stroke team victory over Purdue.
