GOLF WORLD COLLEGE PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Boise State

An eight-stroke victory at the OGI Pacific Coast Intercollegiate was the senior's second straight win and his fourth this season, tying a school record. Merritt's 14-under 199 at Rancho San Marcos GC in Santa Barbara, Calif., was nearly 26 strokes better than the average score in the tournament. His rounds of 66-68-65 ranked second, T-4 and first for low 18-hole performances in the event.



Dewi Claire Schreefel,
Southern California

The 2006 NCAA medalist parred the first extra hole to beat defending champ Anna Nordqvist of Arizona State and win the Ping/ASU Invitational Sunday. Both players finished at seven-under 209 at ASU's Karsten Course in Tempe after Schreefel bogeyed the final hole (No. 18) in regulation, the same one she would par in the playoff. Her performance helped the Trojans also claim the team title.
