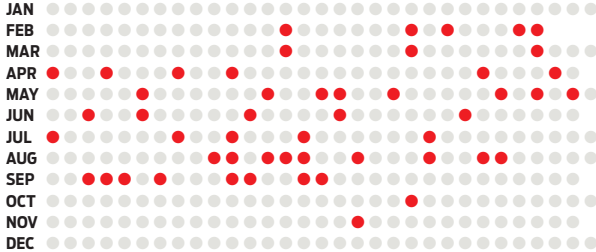

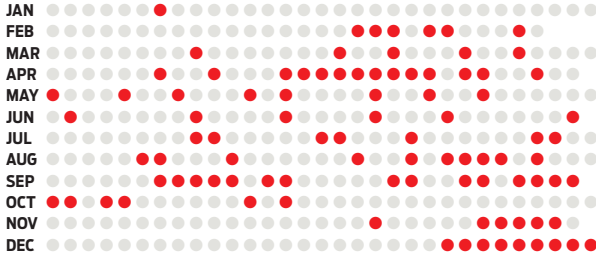

## 1953



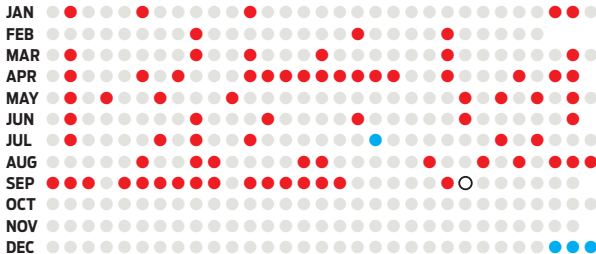

## 1954



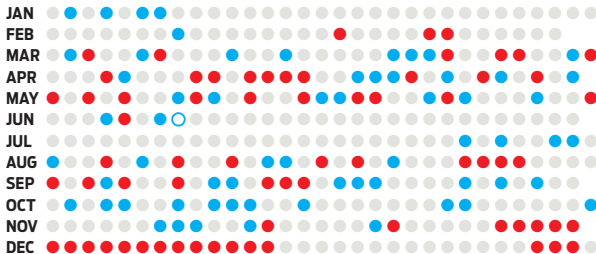

## 1955



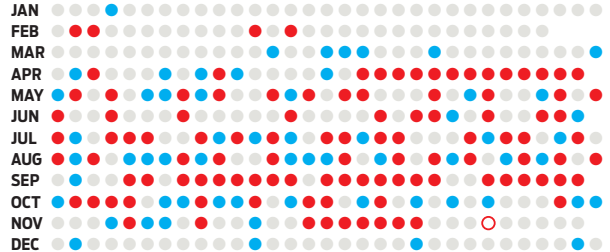

## 1956



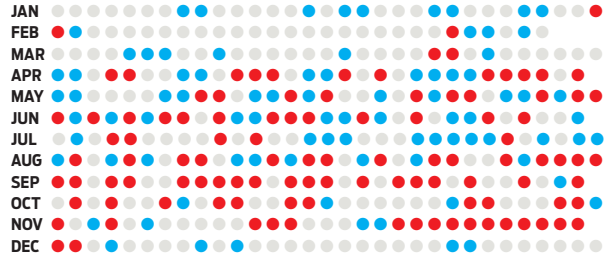

## 1957



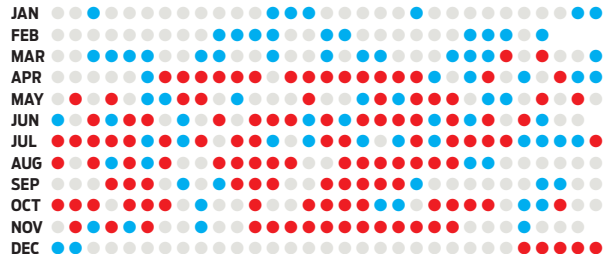

## 1958



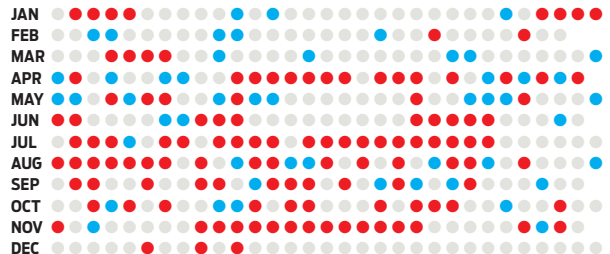

## 1959



**World events:** Castro takes power in Cuba after Batista is driven from Havana. . . . Alaska and Hawaii become states. . . . Dalai Lama flees Tibet. . . . Khrushchev meets with Eisenhower at Camp David.

**World events:** American U-2 spy plane shot down over Soviet Union. . . . Eisenhower signs Civil Rights Act. . . . Khrushchev pounds shoe on table at United Nations. . . . John F. Kennedy wins presidential election.
